

Suzuki LTZ 400 Cam Chain Tensioner Extension

Ref: Excessive Engine Valve Train Noise

This kit was developed to quiet valve train noise, caused by long-term use and/or high-RPM riding. BEFORE INSTALLING THIS KIT: verify that the valves are within factory specs.

- 1. Remove seat and right-side tank cowling.
- 2. Remove breather lines from the black box, located behind the right side of the motor, just above the exhaust pipe. Remove bolt at rear of box and remove box.
- 3. Locate Cam Chain Tensioner. Remove 12mm hex cap. CAUTION: cap is under spring pressure. Remove cap, spring and washer. Remove two 5mm allen-head bolts, holding Cam Chain Tensioner to cylinder head. Remove Cam Chain Tensioner from motor.
- 4. Locate roll-pin on end of Cam Chain Tensioner arm that holds the end cap to the tensioner arm. Drive roll-pin out with small, round punch and remove end cap. Install new end cap, reinstall and center roll-pin into tensioner arm.
- 5. Completely collapse cam chain adjuster, by depressing the ratchet and pushing the tensioner arm into the tensioner body.
- 6. Clean gasket surfaces and install new gasket. Reinstall Cam Chain Tensioner, using the two mounting bolts. Torque to 7.0lbs/ft. Install spring, washer and 12mm hex cap. Torque hex cap to 21.5lb/ft.
- 7. Reassemble remaining items in reverse order of disassembly.
